IN-PERSON APPOINTMENTS

Schedule an individual appointment with a writing instructor at our main Writing Center in Helen C. White Hall or at one of our satellite locations across campus.



WRITING GROUPS

Meet regularly with other writers to set goals for your writing, celebrate accomplishments together, and sustain work on a longer project.



VIRTUAL MEETINGS

Set up an online meeting to discuss your draft with a writing instructor.



WORKSHOPS

Attend our free workshops to learn about writing genres, craft, style, and more.



WRITTEN FEEDBACK

Submit your draft electronically to a writing instructor, who will respond with suggestions for revising and strengthening your work.
